

RESOLUTION NO. 17-13

**A Resolution of the Scientific and Cultural Facilities District  
Pertaining to Fiscal Year 2018 Expenditures and Revenues for the General and Expendable  
Trust Funds and Adopting the 2018 Budget**

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the Scientific and Cultural Facilities District, pursuant to C.R.S. §29-1-105, has appointed Deborah Jordy, Executive Director, to prepare and submit a proposed budget to said governing body at the proper time; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Jordy submitted a proposed budget to this governing body on September 28, 2017 for its consideration; and

WHEREAS, upon due and proper notice, published and posted in accordance with C.R.S. §29-1-106, said proposed budget was open for inspection by the public at the SCFD office, a public hearing was held on October 26, 2017, and interested taxpayers were given the opportunity to inspect the proposed budget and file or register any objections to said proposed budget, and;

WHEREAS, whatever increases may have been made in the expenditures, like increases were added to the revenues or planned to be expended from reserves/fund balances so that the budget remains in balance, as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE SCIENTIFIC AND CULTURAL FACILITIES DISTRICT AS FOLLOWS:


